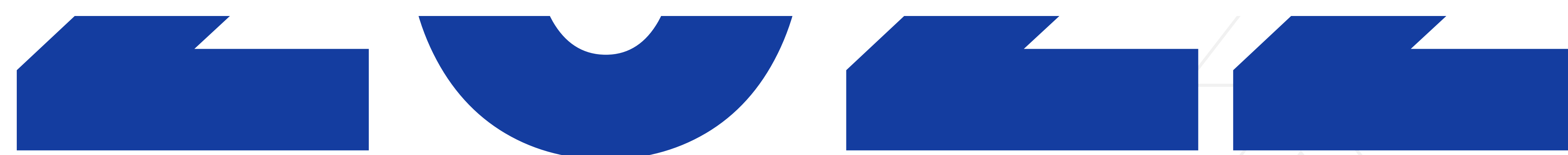

# ABOUT PROJECT WASH



**PROJECT WASH** is designed to provide technical assistance and training plans to individuals and communities without access to **clean and safe water**. We work with a wide range of stakeholders to identify and plan appropriate water projects that will enhance **self-sustainable operations** and **community livelihoods**.



# ABOUT PROJECT WASH



We have also surveyed **over 120 communities** in **Nigeria** and identified the need to implement improvements in cost-effective and environmentally responsible manner. Findings from the site investigations have also served as basis for evaluating feasibility of **building new water sources** against repairing existing water sources.





# The outcomes of PROJECT WASH includes:



**Training of community members and water resource committees to ensure environmental sustainability;**



**Improved efficiency of water facilities in partner communities, through technical support and training plans;**



**Increased public awareness of measures contributing to water management and environmental protection, with enhanced monitoring tools and knowledge sharing;**

**Preparedness to address water vulnerabilities in Nigeria, by engaging stakeholders in the areas of water innovation, research, policy, and capacity development; and**

# Ensuring Community Empowerment



We recognise the need for communities to be trained in proper hygiene practices and provided with adequate toilet facilities, handwashing stations, and other healthcare necessities. Hence, **we spread the information far and wide** – through **community-wide training, WASH committees, and mobilisation of community health workers**. By empowering communities to be a part of water solutions, we equip them with resources to create changes for generations to come.



# Promoting Environmental Sustainability



We believe that Nigeria can attain **water sustainability** by ensuring that there is enough **clean and safe water** to meet multiple needs, without compromising the ability of future generations to do the same. Indeed, achieving sustainable water management requires a multidisciplinary and holistic approach in which technical, environmental, economic, societal and cultural issues are addressed. **By designing and executing feasible water projects in communities, we provide adequate water quantity and appropriate water quality** without compromising the future ability to provide this capacity and quality.



## **Provision of WASH System**



**Supplied over 500,000 litres of water to 6 communities in Nigeria.**



**Installed solar-powered boreholes in 2 communities in Nigeria.**



**Improved opportunities for 4,000 children to attend schools.**



**Installed intelligent water dispenser with integrated revenue collection platform, to improve water management in rural communities.**



**Completed water projects benefiting over 25,000 residents in diverse communities.**
